SOUND SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

If the event is in a venue other than a church with a professionally installed sound system, please contact Geoff Moore's road manager for system requirements.

<u>INPUTS</u>

We will send 3 XLR inputs to the front of house. They are for 2 vocal mics and 1 acoustic guitar DI. Those inputs will come out of a small IEM rack on the stage. We will have our own mics (Shure ULX wireless), as well as our own ear monitors (Sennheiser EW300) that we will mix from the stage. We will not need wedges unless otherwise requested.

STAGE ITEMS NEEDED

- (2) Mic Stands with booms centered at front of platform. (we have clips to fit our ULX mics)
- (2) Wood Top Stools positioned behind mic stands.
- (2) Bottles of water placed on stools.
- (1) Guitar Stand for acoustic.
- 110V power at rack position and at front of stage for guitar pedalboard.

SOUND CHECK

Our set up and sound check typically requires 30 minutes. Please confirm with Geoff's road manager optimum arrival time at church or venue.

LIGHTING

For concerts and special music, we would like the house lights off or dimmed and the main focus of the lights to be set at the center of the stage. For worship sets in a church, we encourage lighting to be as typical for their weekly worship experience.

<u>VIDEO</u>

Video will be needed for any events including corporate worship where lyrics are to be projected, and for events involving Compassion International where we have an MP4 video which will need to be shown at some time during the set.

MERCHANDISING

We will need (1) 6-8ft table in the lobby for CD sales after church services or after a concert. If available, we could use the help of a volunteer at the table between each service (or after concert) to help with sales and tear down of display. Volunteer can meet with Geoff's guitarist at the merch table 15 min before start of the service or concert for instruction.

DRESSING ROOMS / GREEN ROOM

One dressing room is required. This room can be an office, a choir room, etc. It should have water and coffee available. Having a small assortment of breakfast items is appreciated on Sunday mornings, but not required. Thank you!
